Milestones in Healthcare

Mandera County had one of the worst health indicators in the Country before the advent of devolution. With adequate investment towards reversing these trends, the County has been on a trajectory of improvement since 2013.

Immunization coverage rose from 28% in 2013 to 74% in 2020. Antenatal attendance increased from 20.3% to 84.4% in 2020 while delivery conducted by skilled attendant increased from 11% in 2013 to 72% in 2020. This tremendous improvement of service utilization was as a result of improved access to health services by the communities as functional health care facilities were increased from 33 to 98. Family planning uptake has increased from 2.8% in 2013 to 10.5% in 2020. There has been a drastic reduction of maternal mortality from as high as 3,795/100,000 live births in 2013 to less than 500/100,000 live births in 2020

Bitumen Roads Mandera Town roads (24Km)

- » Construction of Concrete Bridge in Mandera Town.
- » Construction of box culverts in various parts of the county including.
- » All weather Murram roads -1,800kms
- » Drifts- Construction of more than 70 drifts across seasonal streams.

Mandera County was severely water scarce and sanitation poor before devolution. Safe water and adequate sanitation underpin poverty reduction, economic growth and healthy ecosystems. The county has been determined in resolving the chronic shortage worsened by climate change.

On the flip side, Mandera County is prone to disasters such as recurrent drought, floods, conflicts and famine. Lately locust invasion in 2019 to 2021 compounded the challenges wiping out vegetation and leaving pastoralists desperate.

Achievements by the County Government and its partners over the past seven and a half years:-

Establishment of Mandera Water and Sewerage Company and Elwak Water and Sewerage Company

In partnership with the National Government and Africa Development Bank, Ksh.2.4 billion water and sanitation project is ongoing. The project is expected to deliver 16 million litres of water daily.

- » The current water demand for Mandera municipality is about 5.4 million litres per day. This can only address 36.6% current water demand of Mandera municipality residents.
- » The percentage of the County's population being served through water trucking was reduced from 36% in 2013 to 6% by March 2021
- » The population of rural population with access to safe and reliable water services increased from 43.6% in 2013 to 70% by March 2021.
- » The population of urban population with access to safe and reliable water services similarly increased from 31.3% in 2013 to 52% by March 2021
- » The total population of the County with reasonable access to safe and reliable water services increased from 46% in 2013 to 70% by March 2021
- » In abid to contribute ending drought emergency policy, Mandera County Government has drilled 70 boreholes in one year.

Greening Mandera County

We have aggressively implemented afforestation programme with over 250,000 tree seedlings were planted, nurtured and maintained across the county.

Programme covered the following areas; A13 Road/Major Street within Mandera Town, KMTC, MTTI, County HQ, Proposed County HQ, Moi Stadium, Ministry of Water Compound, Mandera Secondary School, Mandera Teachers Training College, Busle Streets, Mandawasco Office, Municipality Office, New Official Governor residence, Mandera Referral Hospital, Fire Station Compound, Governor's Farm, Banisa Dam, Banisa Social Hall, Rhamu Hospital, Girisa Dispensary, Al-furqan Integrated School.

The climate change mitigation programme had 1,300 women were employed to perform casual tree growing and routine watering in the hot dry weather.

- » Distributed over 100,000 tree seedlings to farmers, households and public institutions to enhance forest cover. This mainly targeted the riverine areas of farmland where they were given endogenous trees to conserve ecosystem.
- » Spearheaded environmental education and public awareness creation on the importance of environmental conservation.
- » Distribution of afforestation tools such as Watering cans, hoes, wheelbarrows to make work easy.

EDUCATION

- » Mandera County Government has invested over Kshs.4.6 billion over the years to improve the education sector. Our investment has mainly been in ECD centers, ECD College, Mandera Teachers Training College (MTTC), Vocational colleges across the sub-counties with 903 students actively learning various courses. We have constructed Modern administration blocks for the two National Secondary schools in our county.
- » Our current enrolment in ECD classes stands at 23,449 from 17,000 learners with only four teachers trained and the rest were taught by class eight Volunteers paid by the parents. Mandera County Government has employed 520 ECDE Teachers.
- » Mandera County has 297 public ECDE centers
- » 23,499 ECDE learners are enrolled (13,704 Boys and 9,745 Girls)
- » Centres managed by 412 ECDE teachers
- » Kshs.440million bursary fund to support bright and poor students in the last five years.
